Information on the draw

- 1. Each category (both main draw and division 1) is played in knock out format.
- The dates for completion of each round of each category are specific to that category of competition. Please check the draw sheet for round completion dates.
- 3. An updated Draw sheet shall be issued fortnightly.
- 4. The following players from the Division 1 competition draws shall earn a place in the Main Draw of the same competition

5. The Club is block booking Courts 4 and 5 between 6pm and 9pm in the week of September 9th to provide court time for any outstanding semi-finals to be played. It is not a requirement that these matches be played at this time, but courts will be reserved to assist players with a backlog of matches. If you need court time that week please email info@parktennis.co.uk FAO Pete/Rachel to request a slot and your availability. We will get back to you with options.

Championship Rules

General rules

- To enter you must be a full member of the Club for the duration of your participation in the Championships.
- 2. You may only enter the Legends competitions if you are at least 60 years of age on 4th June 2023.
- 3. If you enter a Doubles competition and during the course of the Championships (after having played at least one match) either you or your partner is injured and unable to play any further matches, your pairing is eliminated. The non-injured player is not permitted to continue in the Championships with another partner. Should this occur please email info@parktennis.co.uk FAO Pete/Rachel as soon as possible to let us know.
- 4. If you enter one of the Doubles competitions and you or your partner is injured and unable to play before you play your first match, the non-injured player may find an alternative partner provided that player is not playing in that category with another partner and/or has not already been eliminated from that category as part of another pairing.
- 5. The Club will add the £5 tournament fee to all players' Court Reserve account. You will be notified when this has been done.

Match Rules

Players are reminded that all matches are to be played in the right spirit. Do bring your
competitive side and go for the win but we expect all players to display good
sportsman/sportsperson like behaviour. Any concerns should be reported to the Club's

- Match Secretary. Warnings may be issued to anyone who does not observe this requirement and any further action which may be required includes removal from the Championships.
- Players are responsible for providing their own balls for matches. The Club only provides balls for Finals Day matches. Players should provide new or nearly new balls for matches.
- Players should be prepared to be available to play Finals on Finals Day which this year, is
 September 14th. Finals will not be played on any other date.
- 4. For all matches, excluding Finals Day matches, it is the responsibility of the players to arrange a date and time for matches to be played and to book court time. We recommend booking either a 90 minute or 2 hour slot.
- 5. When booking courts on Court Reserve, please list the reservation type not as doubles or singles but as "CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP" this allows the Tournament Committee to check that all matches and rounds are on schedule.
- Players should aim to play all matches by the relevant completion date for each round (see relevant draw sheets).
- 7. Where players cannot play a match before the relevant completion date for that round it must be played within the next 5 days. If players cannot agree a date within such extended timeframe, please emails info@parktennis.co.uk FAO Pete/Rachel. It is important that this schedule is adhered otherwise the Main Draw cannot get under way on time.
- 8. All matches shall be played as the best of 3 sets.

- 9. If a match enters a 3rd set the 3rd set shall be played as a 10 point match tie break set.
- 10. Players are responsible for calling their own lines.
- 11. The winner/winning pairing in each match shall be responsible for submitting the match result.
